ST. MARY'S HARBOUR LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

THE ISLANDS REGATTA 2016

Valid From: 26th- 29th August 2016 - Self-Cancelling

Mariners are advised that over this coming weekend, the 'Islands Regatta' will take place which will see a number of maritime events both within the Islands and here within the harbour. All Harbour users should be aware of the program of events as follows:

Friday 26th

The event will commence on the afternoon of Friday 26th when the flotilla arrives within the Islands. The Royal Navy Frigate HMS Sutherland will also arrive in the Islands at this time, anchoring in St. Mary's Roads

Saturday 27th

The 'Round Island Race' will start at 11:00 and will see approx. 40 vessels race **clockwise** around St Mary's, finishing on St Agnes. The Royal Navy will be the starting official for this.

Sunday 28th

The 'Parade of Sail' will start from St Mary's Harbour at 10:30 led by our pilot vessel 'Pegasus'. Around 30 vessels are expected to take part in this parade before they proceed to Tresco.

A water carnival will take place within the Harbour between 14:30-16:30. This will include a raft race at 15:30. Please be very aware of this when transiting the Harbour.

HMS Sutherland will be accepting guests between 10:00 and 16:00. The vessel 'Liberty Lass' will be ferrying guests from the harbour throughout this time.

Monday 29th

HMS Sutherland will be accepting guests between 10:00 and 14:00. The vessel 'Liberty Lass' will be ferrying guests throughout this time.

The Red Arrows will perform an aerobatic display at 15:00. We request that all vessels restrict their movements within the harbour between 14:50 and 15:30.
