The dive contractor agrees to notify the harbour office of any change in the proposed plans as soon as practical and in all cases prior to the commencement of the altered operations.

The dive contractor agrees to contact St Mary's Harbour prior to, and upon completion of each dive.

The dive contractor agrees to keep a listening watch on both VHF Channel 14 and 16 at all times whilst engaged in operations within St Mary's Harbour.
